

Aladdin Kids Cast of Characters

Aladdin

Aladdin is a poor street urchin with a good heart who sometimes loses his way while trying to survive. Playful, funny, caring, and adventurous, Aladdin requires a charismatic performer capable of balancing comedy with emotional sincerity. This is one of the show's strongest singing roles. *Gender: Male*

Genie

Genie is the fun-loving, scene-stealing magical spirit trapped inside the lamp. Full of energy, humor, and theatricality, Genie drives much of the show's comedy and spectacle. This role works best with a performer who has excellent comic timing and strong stage presence. *Gender: Any*

Iago

Iago is Jafar's sarcastic parrot sidekick. Though the role has limited singing, Iago relies heavily on comedic delivery, attitude, and expressive reactions. *Gender: Any*

Jafar

Jafar is the power-hungry Royal Vizier determined to take control of Agrabah. He presents himself as a loyal advisor while secretly plotting for power. Cast a strong actor capable of balancing villainy, comedy, and dramatic authority. *Gender: Male*

Jasmine

Jasmine is the Princess of Agrabah who longs to experience life beyond the palace walls. Intelligent, independent, and compassionate, Jasmine wants to help her people and choose her own future. This role requires strong acting and singing skills. *Gender: Female*

Lamp Vendor

The Lamp Vendor acts as the show's storyteller and narrator. This fast-talking marketplace vendor helps guide the audience into the magical world of Agrabah. The role is ideal for a confident actor with clear diction and strong stage presence.

Gender: Any

Sultan

Sultan is Jasmine's warm-hearted father and the ruler of Agrabah. Loving but committed to tradition, he struggles to balance royal law with his daughter's wishes. Cast a performer who can portray kindness and authority naturally.

Gender: Male (speaking part only)

Bread Vendor

The Bread Vendor is the aggravated marketplace merchant from whom Aladdin steals food early in the story. This role offers a fun comedic moment for a featured ensemble performer.

Gender: Any (speaking part only)

Fruit Vendor

The Fruit Vendor is a friendly merchant helping create the lively atmosphere of Agrabah's marketplace.

Gender: Any (speaking part only)

Prince Abdullah, Prince Hassim, and Prince Malik

These royal suitors hope to marry Jasmine and become Sultan. Overconfident, dramatic, and completely self-important, the princes provide broad comedy opportunities for performers who enjoy exaggerated character work.

Gender: Male (speaking part only)

Cave Guardian

The Cave Guardian is the mysterious protector of the Cave of Wonders who warns Aladdin to touch only the lamp. This role can be performed onstage or as an offstage voice and should feel imposing and magical.

Gender: Any (speaking part only)

Avis

Avis is the magical flying carpet. This non-speaking role relies entirely on expressive movement, storytelling through dance, and stage presence. Many schools stage Avis creatively using fabric, choreography, or puppetry techniques.

Gender: Any

Ensemble

The ensemble includes Djinn, Agrabahns, Guards, Beggars, Skeletons of past prisoners, and Prince Ali's Entourage. These flexible groups allow schools to expand participation and create large musical moments throughout the show. Ensemble performers help bring the marketplace, palace, dungeon, and parade scenes to life.
